2. CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER/MAYOR'S INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

Mayor Lawrance called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

The Mayor welcomed everyone and announced that a third member on the Board will be joining soon. He also announced that Jackie Trenholm the Administrative Assistant for the Municipality will be the Secretary/Contact Person for the Board.

3. ELECTION OF CHAIR PERSON

Ms. Darlene Angeconeb was elected Chairperson.

4. PRESENTATIONS

Mr. Graham Wight, MCSCS Presentation:

Mr. Wight provided the following information on what to expect as a Police Services Board:

- The Board will be an Advisory Board to the Detachment Commander
- The Board and Detachment Commander should be on the same page

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a. Policing arrangement with Sioux Lookout:

- The Board will have access and the means to apply for funding, there is a number of funding grants to apply for.
- MCSCS can be of assistance to the funding process.
- The Board will establish their budget and travel costs for training. This will be covered through the Municipality.
- The Board must work out what the Board Budget should be.

b. Relationship between the Police Service Board (PSB) and Municipality Discussion:

 The Board is independent of the Municipality although members are appointed by Council.

c. Policing in Ontario:

- The Chairperson is the first point of contact for the Detachment Commander
- All correspondence will flow through the elected Chairperson to be distributed to the board members
- Graham defined Chiefs Memo i.e. funding, problems or issues and provincial initiatives that are emailed out weekly, recommended that the Chair or secretary review and distribute what is important or relative to the other board members.

d. Governance:

- Reviewed roles and responsibilities
- Discussion on Section 10 and Reports
 - Communication agreements
 - Business plans are reviewed every 3yrs
 - Reports and annual reviews, crimes, trends etc.
 - The term of a board member is no longer than the term of council
 - The board is not a subcommittee of Council
- Roles and duty of the OPP and members of the Board defined by Graham
- How to handle complaints
 - It is not the role of the board to entertain complaints as there is an opportunity and feedback form available to the public
 - Feedback forms are available at the detachment and can be made available at the Municipal office
 - Board meeting shall be open to the public
 - Discussions on what is discussed on camera ie: no discuss of personnel issue should ever be discussed on camera
 - Examples of the types of annual reports the PSB would receive were discussed, Detachment Commander to supply to the PSB

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 The PSB can initiate public feedback and initiate public surveys if motivated or necessary

Mr. Dan Davidson. Inspector, OPP Sioux Lookout Detachment Presentation on the Summary of the Detachments Role with the Police Services Board:

- o Summarized the Detachments role with contracts
- o Detachment Commander reporting to the PSB and what they can expect
- Reports are distributed quarterly
- Complaints system (public) report, crimes that occurred, trends, statistics and other examples of reports were reviewed and discussed
- Dan advised that all concerns from the PSB should be conveyed to the Detachment Commander prior to a PSB meeting date, so that a proper investigation and completed reports can be presented at the meeting to expedite any delays
- PSB meeting can be conducted quarterly or however agreed upon by the board ie: monthly vs quarterly
- Reports should be given to the PSB prior to all meetings
- The Board should set up their priorities and objectives as a board; i.e.: what to focus on and what are the issues that should be discussed
