**Sioux Lookout Expands its Inventory of
Serviced Commercial and Industrial Lots**

The Municipality of Sioux Lookout's Airport and Economic Development Commissions are pleased to announce the availability of serviced commercial and industrial lots. The introduction of municipal sewer and water servicing to the Airport was completed in December 2009, replacing the need for private water and septic services and bringing the airport into compliance with the provincial Drinking Water Systems Regulation.

The Sioux Lookout Airport is a regional economic driver and the Municipality's hub for air service in Northern Ontario with over 165,000 passengers utilizing airport services on an annual basis.

"The availability of fully serviced lots will enable us to attract new business and development opportunities to Airport lands and facilitate the attainment of our capital plan objectives," stated Bill Hochstedler, Airport Commission Chair.

Economic Development Commission Chair, Brad Hyslop states, "With over \$200 million in capital projects currently underway in Sioux Lookout, the newly serviced commercial and industrial lands allow us to expand our target markets to further grow the economy of our community".

The provision of sewer and water servicing enables the creation of additional airside and groundside lots at the Airport and to develop lands north of the airport as well as municipally-owned property on the entire northern boundary of Big Wood Lake.
