A staff member will contact applicants to discuss their desire to be a part of the LIT program. One requirement for youth in this program is a genuine desire to be involved in a leadership capacity. This opportunity should be considered a basic job skills program that is fun and exciting but also aimed at building skills that the youth can use later in life. They will be key members of our team and play an active role in making the camp programs safe and enjoyable for participants. If we feel the youth is uninterested or not ready for this role we may suggest the youth join our regular camp programs.

Instead of receiving a salary, LIT's will receive a significantly discounted camp fee. If the LIT is not able to fulfill the expectations of an LIT we reserve the right to remove them from this position.

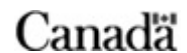

Assumption of Risk and Responsibility Form Cedar Bay Day Camp (LIT's) – Summer 2010



New Vision Unlimited is a Not-For-Profit organization that is dedicated to helping people develop vision and direction for their lives through engaging them in fun and empowering adventure learning opportunities. As a junior member of the day camp staff the LIT will be involved in assisting with a program that includes:

- Activities in or around water including water games and free swim as well as electives including swimming lessons, kayaking, and canoeing (if registered)
- Interaction with a variety of artistic materials which may include but is not limited to paint, pencil, clay, fabric, fabric dye, glue, and plants.
- Activities indoors and outdoors
- Participants will be outdoors for a significant portion of the day including days were there is light rain. In the case of heavy rain or thunderstorms activities will be relocated indoors.
- may include bike riding, and walking on or beside town roads for field trips or to walk to an from the Recreation Centre
- moderate physical activity which may include activities such as low ropes course and climbing wall, camp games, archery, geo-tracking, karate (if registered) and team sports
- horse care and horseback riding (if registered for this elective)
- periodic field trips for the purposes of education or recreation
- potential over night camping experiences

I understand that:

- Participants are responsible for bringing peanut free lunches if they haven't registered for the Healthy Lunch program, as well as healthy snacks and beverages
- Participants are responsible for dressing appropriately for the outdoors including sun block, bug spray and weather appropriate clothing (including rain coats). Please note, campers will be spending the majority of time outdoors regardless of rain, except in the case of heavy rain or thunder storms.
- The camp does not have a nurse or health care provider on site and therefore medications will not be distributed to campers.
- All program staff, volunteers and summer students have passed a Criminal Record Check and have Emergency First Aid certification.
- All activities requiring special skills will be offered by certified instructors. This includes the activities contracted out to companies and organizations as well as free swim and swimming lessons, karate, wall climbing, rope course challenges which will be facilitated by New VU camp staff.
- Pictures and/or video may be taken of my child for use in New Vision Unlimited's promotional materials which may include, but is not limited to, website, newspaper, DVD and other printed materials. Parents are responsible for notifying New Vision Unlimited if they do not give consent.
- The Municipality of Sioux Lookout and New Vision Unlimited do not provide any accidental, death, disability, dismemberment or medical expense insurance for people participating in their programs (or using their property) and it is the responsibility of the participants or parents/guardians to ensure the participant has appropriate insurance.
- While proper safety and precautionary measures will be taken, neither Municipality of Sioux Lookout, New Vision Unlimited nor its staff can guarantee total safety of participants because some risks are beyond their control.
